King Charles the 1st used our main function room to hold his council of war and it is this very room we have available for tour groups wishing to visit this historical landmark.

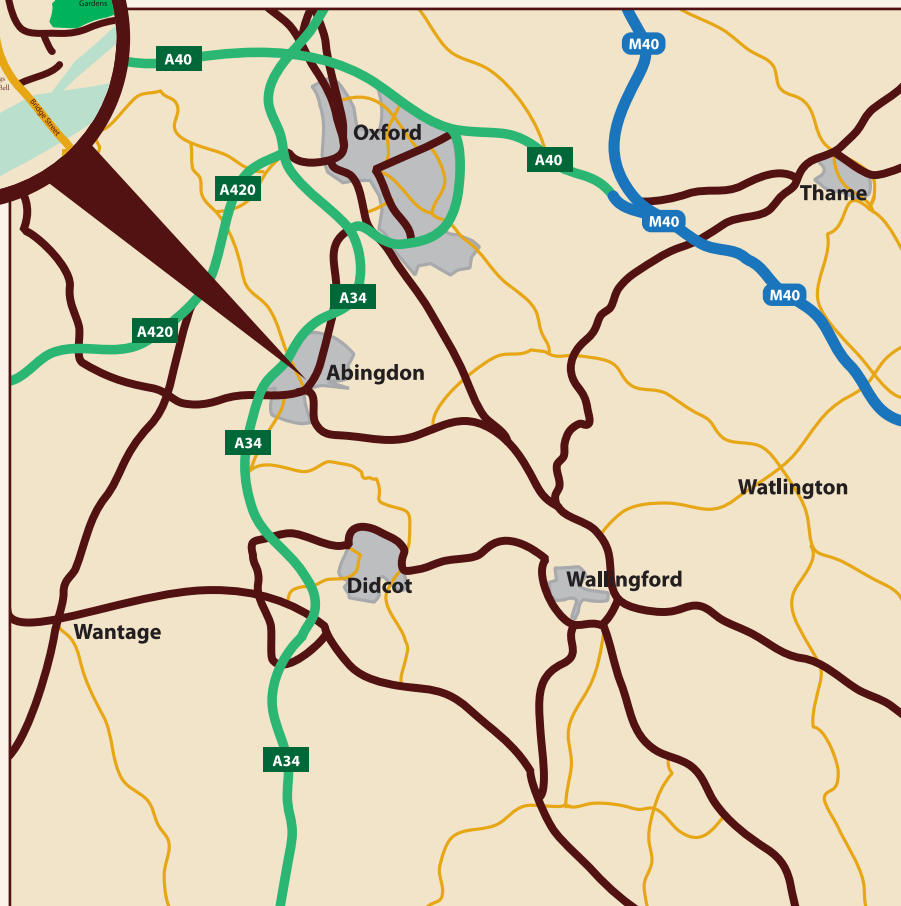
